The Challenge

Governments across sectors face recurring difficulties in delivering welfare, subsidies, and assistance efficiently and fairly.

A system designed to support governments in collating beneficiary data, confirming eligibility, and delivering assistance reliably.

- Single, de-duplicated worker identity across the system. 
- Digitised attendance data captured directly in the field and synced automatically with the main server. 
- Entitlements issued as tamper-resistant digital verifiable credentials. 
- Offline face authentication tool with liveness for on-ground delivery. 
- A unified, state-linked lifecycle connecting registration, eligibility, issuance, and redemption. 
- Eligibility-locked issuance enforced through verified work history, with end-to-end audit trails

Target Audience



ISSUER

Construction companies, contractors, and field supervisors who manage large, mobile workforces.

They need a simple way to record work history and issue digital work completion certificates for timely wage-linked benefits.



HOLDER

Migrant workers, daily-wage earners, and informal labour groups who frequently move between sites.

They need portable, trustworthy proof of work and a seamless way to access assistance without paperwork.



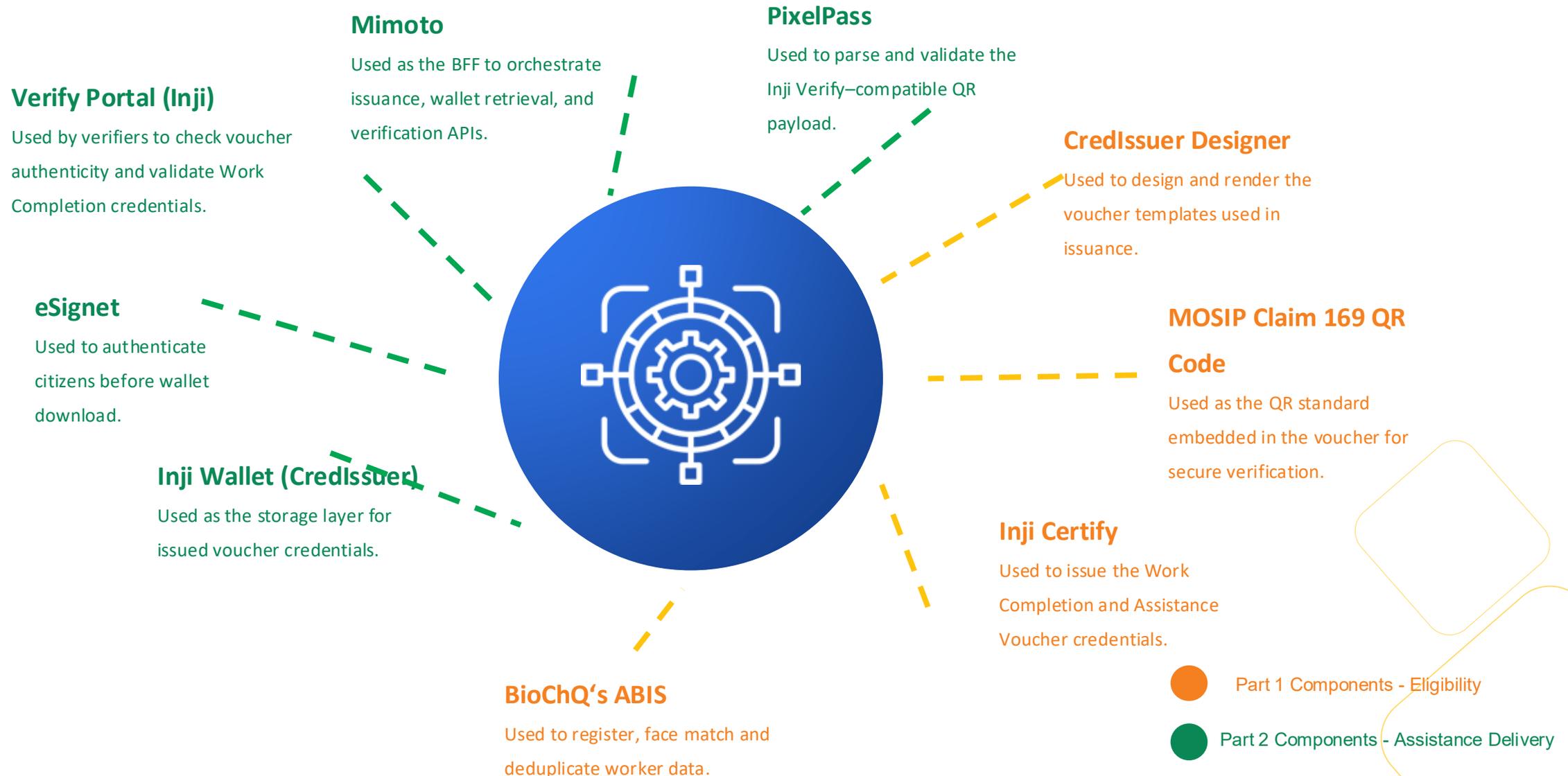
VERIFIER

Government departments, local authorities, and welfare agencies responsible for distributing benefits.

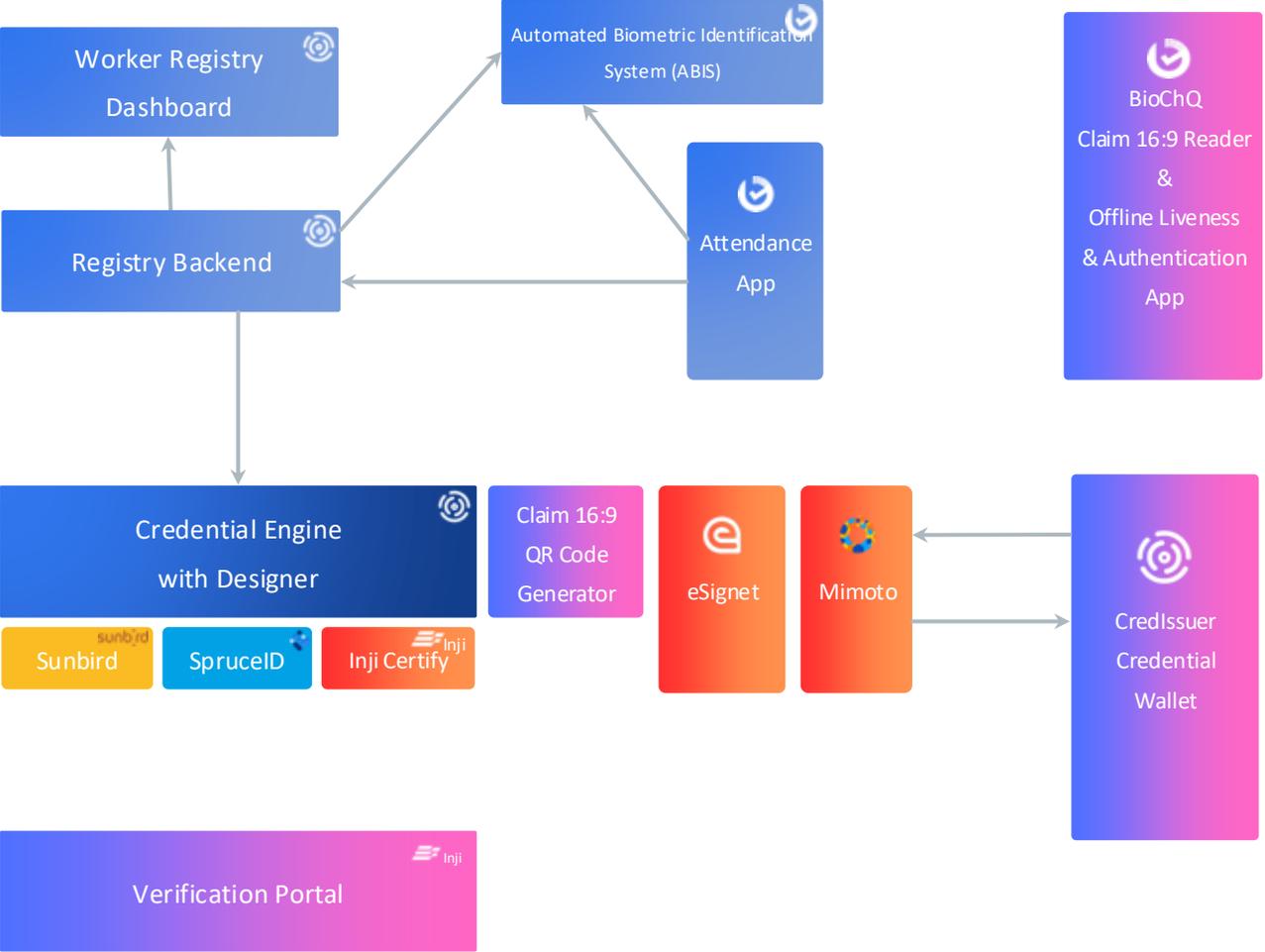
They need a secure, tamper-proof method to confirm worker identity, validate eligibility, and ensure benefits reach the right person.

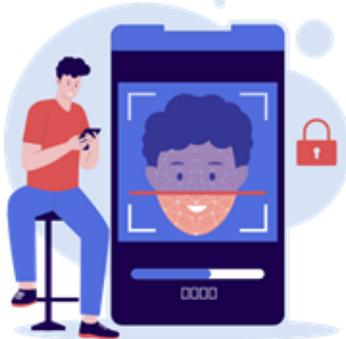
Each Component Purpose-Built for the Assistance Delivery Flow



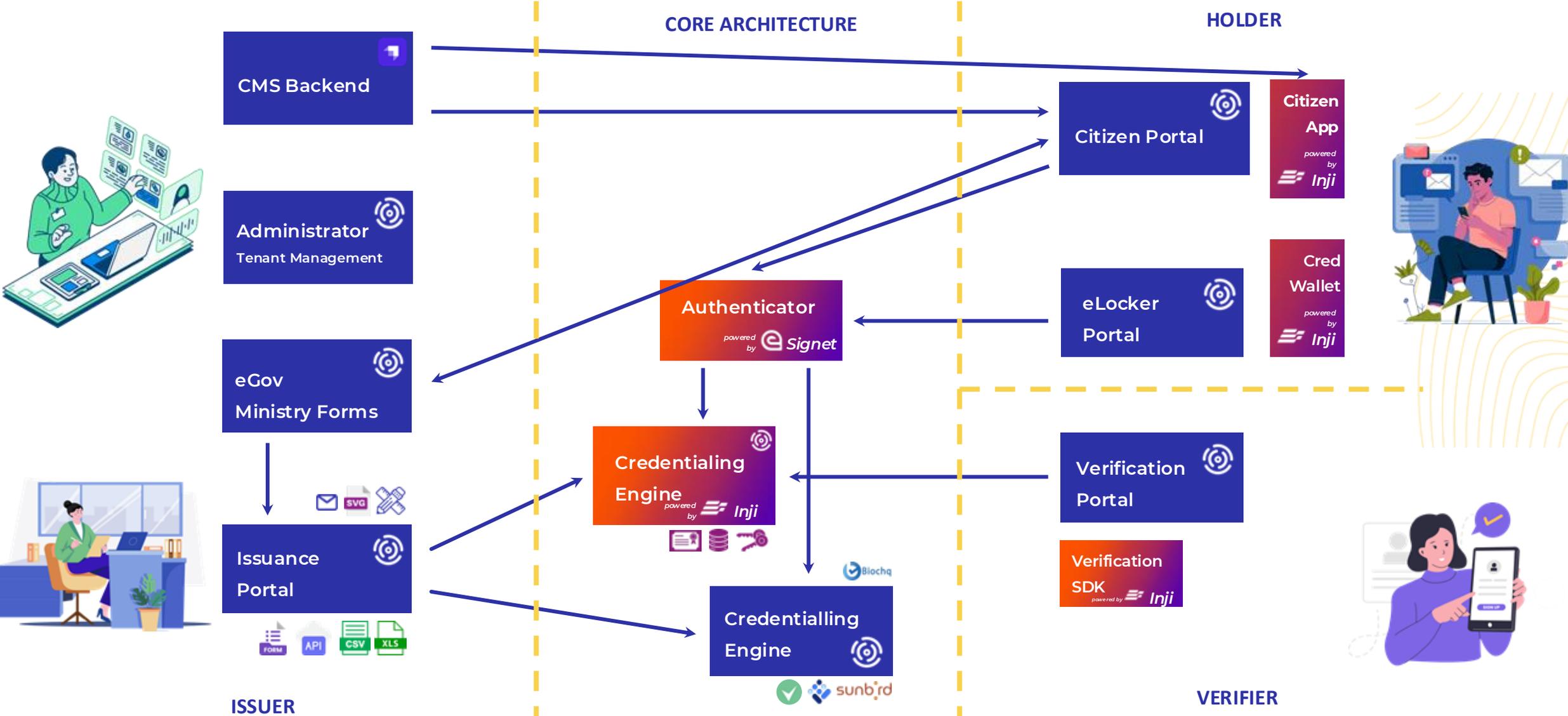
AidFlow Workflow Diagram



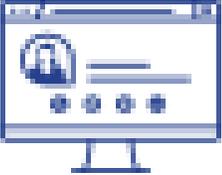

How AidFlow Operates At A Glance

Issuer Creates Worker Profile

Admin records demographic details and uploads work activity/history for each worker.

Completion of Work Cert is Triggered

Once required workdays are completed, a Work Completion Credential is generated.

Government Issues Gov Assistance

Government validates the Work Completion Credential and issues a Voucher Credential.

Citizen Gets Notified by Email

Citizen receives the voucher via email and can store it in the CI Wallet or request a printed copy.

Voucher Redemption via BioChQ App

Citizen's voucher is scanned; BioChQ performs liveness + face match; redemption is verified and payout is released.

AidFlow prioritises accessibility, usability, and trust—ensuring no beneficiary is excluded due to language, connectivity, or digital barriers.

- **Multilingual Support**

Enables beneficiaries and field staff to interact in local and regional languages.

- **Offline Biometric Verification**

Face authentication works without internet, ensuring continuity in low-connectivity areas.

- **Low Digital Literacy–Friendly Flows**

Simple, guided interactions reduce dependence on technical training.

- **Last-Mile Deployability**

Designed for rural, mobile, and informal settings where infrastructure is limited.

- **Privacy-First Verification**

Confirms identity without exposing or storing sensitive personal data.
