Objective:

This session equips country teams and system integrators with practical insight to plan and deliver successful OpenCRVS implementations. It helps practitioners make informed decisions that enable them to get full value from OpenCRVS as a secure, configurable digital civil registration system that supports a country's full civil registration requirements.

The session will begin with a live demonstration of the current OpenCRVS platform, introducing core capabilities and configuration options. Building on this, the OpenCRVS team will highlight functionality that countries should plan for early, including an overview of the expanded configurability expected in OpenCRVS 2.0, planned for release in Q2 2026.

Drawing on real-world deployment experience, the session will share practical implementation learnings, focusing on common challenges and how they can be addressed through smart planning and configuration choices. Emphasis will be placed on approaches that result in systems that are simple for end users, easier to maintain, and aligned with strong security and safeguarding standards.
