- **Identify Common Pitfalls:** To collaboratively map the most frequent and high-impact failure points across the DPI lifecycle, from policy formulation to national scale-up.
- **Share Practical Coping Strategies:** To move beyond problems to solutions, enabling participants to share and learn pragmatic, field-tested strategies for navigating and overcoming key obstacles.
- **Accelerate Learning Cycles:** To shorten the learning curve for all participating countries by pre-empting common mistakes and building on the collective experience of the group, and ultimately speed up adoption and implementation of DPI.



- **Generate Actionable Insights:** To synthesise discussions into a set of key takeaways and potential collaborative actions that the 50-in-5 cohort can pursue post-summit.
